### VOTE "APPROVED" R-90 Comprehensive Sex Education

R-90 allows the public to affirm the law passed in 2019 SB 5395. The Comprehensive Sex Education Bill gives children the skills they need to protect themselves. Healthy lifetimes free of abuse and assault will be the gift of R-90. Students may be excused at parent's request.
