Support a Washington Tax on Extreme Wealth

WHEREAS the Washington State Democrats have called for *fair and just tax system for all; by creating a progressive wealth tax*;¹ and,

WHEREAS according to the Institute on Taxation and Economic Policy, Washington State has the most regressive tax system in the country, with the bottom 20% of Washington's lowest-income residents paying nearly 18% of their income for state and local taxes, while those in the highest 20% income bracket pay less than 7% of their income for state and local taxes;² and,

WHEREAS <u>Senate Bill 5486</u> and <u>House Bill 1473</u>, which are titled "Investing in Washington families and creating a more fair tax system by enacting a narrowly tailored property tax on extreme wealth derived from the ownership of stocks, bonds, and other financial intangible property," propose a 1% tax on financial property with an exemption of \$250 million, and the revenue collected will fund public education, housing, disabilities, and taxpayer justice; and,

WHEREAS SB 5486 and HB 1473 would generate more than \$\frac{\$6 \text{ BILLION}}{6 \text{ BILLION}}\$ per biennium for Washington (according to SB 5486's fiscal note), and affect about \$\frac{700 \text{ Washingtonians}}{100 \text{ Washingtonians}}\$ (according to an October 2022 analysis by the state Department of Revenue) fortunate enough to have more than \$250 \text{ million in wealth; and,}

WHEREAS Washington State is facing a crisis in funding for public schools, housing and homelessness, development disability services, climate change resilience, public transit and transportation, physical and mental health care, and more;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the First District Democrats support the creation of a wealth tax to fund needed services for Washingtonians, such as public education, housing, disability programs and supports, climate change resilience, public transit and transportation, and health care; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that First District Democrats call on all Democrats in the Washington State Legislature and the Governor to wholeheartedly support passing the wealth tax.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the First District Democrats thank Senator Derek Stanford, Representative Davina Duerr, and Representative Shelley Kloba for co-sponsoring SB 5486 and HB 1473.
